60th Anniversary Scenic Car Tour

Organisation

1. Welsh Border Car Club will organise the Anniversary Scenic Car Tour, a Touring Assembly on 22nd October 2023. This event forms a part of the 60th Anniversary celebration of Welsh Border Car Club.
2. The event will be held under a Certificate of Exemption issued by Motor Sport UK, these Regulations and any other written instructions given by the organisers. **Permit NO 132708**

Eligibility

3. There are two classes of cars allowed to enter.

Class A - Classic Cars, comprising any car manufactured up to 1991.

Class B – Any other car.

4. The event is open to members of the organising club and members of WAMC and AWMMC affiliated clubs. Members of the public are also invited to participate.
5. Drivers must hold a valid driving licence. A specific competition licence is not required.
6. All cars must hold a V5C Registration Document, be taxed for use on the public highway and carry a valid MOT certificate, if applicable.

Entries

7. Entries are open from the publication of these regulations and close on 15th October 2023.
8. The entry fee of £70 will cover a “tulip” style road book, tour plate to be affixed to the front of the vehicle and a participant’s award. Also included are bacon sandwiches with tea or coffee for drivers and passengers at the start, morning tea/coffee and afternoon tea/coffee at the rest halts. Entrants can book an after-event meal at the finish as Welsh Border Car Club ask them to join in with the later events of the day to celebrate the Club Anniversary. These events include static car displays, videos, photographs, talks and a buffet style meal. Please see the WBCC website for more details.
9. Additional passengers will be accepted at an additional cost of £20 per person.
10. Payment for entries can be made directly by BACS to Welsh Border Car Club Limited

12. The maximum number of cars will be 70 with a minimum of 40, should the minimum not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and return any received entries.
13. Entry fees will be refunded up to the closing date for entries, less a £20 administration fee. Refunds after this date will be subject to a decision by the Clerk of the Course.
14. Should the event be cancelled due to COVID-19, then entrants will be given the option to transfer their entry to next year or to receive a refund.
15. Entry payment is available via cheque and should be made payable to Welsh Border Car Club Limited although BACS payment would be preferred.
16. Upon signing the Entry Form, you are agreeing to follow any COVID-19 regulations put in place by Brecon Motor Club, Motorsport UK and the Welsh Government.
17. Any entrant who driving standards deemed not to be within the spirit of the event may be denied entry to future events.
18. Entries may be refused without a reason given.

Route

19. The event will start from Llansanffraid Football Club (SY22 6AE)– where refreshments will be served.
20. The Finish will be at Weston Pools Village and Fishery (SY10 9ER) just outside Oswestry.
21. The route will be given in an easy to follow “tulip” road book issued at signing on and can be viewed on a printed map.
22. The route will be covered on sheets 125, 126 & 136 OS Landranger series and total approximately 120 miles but will not be essential as maps will be provided in the road book. As part of the anniversary celebrations the route will traverse many of the roads that Welsh Border Car Club have used on their night road events. The route has been designed to show off a number of views and features of this lovely part of the world.

23. Entrants are to be advised that the whilst the majority of the route uses roads that allow two-way traffic some roads are single carriageway. Care & courtesy should be taken with regards other road users.
24. To confirm entrants have traversed the prescribed routes there will be strategically placed marshals or code boards along the route that will must be recorded, together with manned passage controls.
25. Whilst this is not a timed event entrants may be requested to wait at manned controls to allow the event to maintain reasonable gaps between cars.
26. There are fuel stations along the route, as well as near the start venue.
27. The organisers' mileage will be deemed as correct.

Timetable

28. The event timetable will be:

Documentation

29. It is the entrants' responsibility to ensure that the vehicle is taxed, road legal and insured for the purpose being used and all drivers are included. The organisers have the right to exclude any vehicle deemed inappropriate or unsafe. Cars may not carry any advertising or door mounted competition numbers unless by previous agreement.
30. Entrants will be issued with road books, rally plates and route check cards upon successful completion of documentation.
31. Rally plate to be affixed to the car in a forward-facing position – cable ties will be provided.

34. All finishers that have completed the prescribed route within the specified time will be presented with a commemorative finishers' award.
